Day Two

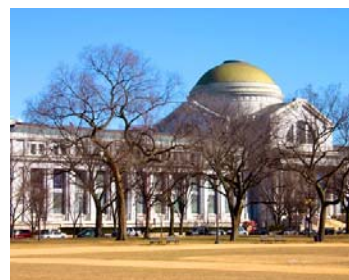
Breakfast at the hotel

Evening walking tour of the Jefferson Memorial and the Iwo Jima Marine Memorial

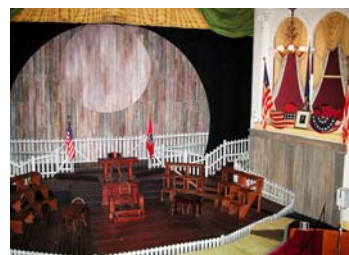


Day Four
