

National Festival of the States – Celebrating America’s 400th Anniversary In Virginia’s Historic Triangle and Washington, D.C.

(4 nights / 5 days)



Day 1 Williamsburg

Midday arrival at Williamsburg. Meet your Williamsburg guide. Take a study tour of America's largest outdoor living history museum. Walk down the streets of Colonial Williamsburg and follow in the footsteps of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Patrick Henry and other patriots. Entrance is also included to the Governor's Palace
Hotel check-in, followed by dinner
Evening guided tour of Historic Williamsburg by candlelight (lantern)

Day 2 Williamsburg

Breakfast at the hotel

Morning guided tour of Jamestown, first settled by Europeans in 1607.

Performance as part of the America’s 400th Anniversary Celebration

Afternoon visit to Yorktown, where the British army under Lord Cornwallis surrendered, thus ending the Revolutionary War, including entrance to the Victory Center. This will complete your tour of the Historic Triangle

Dinner in a local restaurant



Day 3 Williamsburg - Washington DC

Breakfast at the hotel. Hotel check-out. Board the motorcoach for transfer to Washington D.C.

Upon arrival in Washington, D.C., you will be met by your escort/guide at Union Station, who will be with you for the duration of the tour and will guide you through all your sightseeing and performance activities

Take a panoramic coach tour of the Capitol Hill area, seeing the U.S. Capitol, the Supreme Court Building, and the Library of Congress

Check into hotel

Dinner at local restaurant

Evening tour of the Lincoln, Korean, Franklin Delano Roosevelt and Vietnam Memorials



Day 4 Washington DC

Breakfast at the hotel

Tour of Mount Vernon, returning to the city through Old Towne Alexandria

Possible performance (or clinic) as part of the National Festival of the States

Driving tour of Embassy Row, National Cathedral, and visit the Smithsonian Institute’s American History Museum, Natural History Museum, or the Air & Space Museum

Possible performance as part of the National Festival of the States

Dinner at local restaurant

Evening tour of the Jefferson Memorial and the Iwo Jima Marine Memorial

Tour of Arlington National Cemetery to participate in the special U.S. Military Wreath

Laying Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown

Afternoon transfer to airport or coach departure for home
