Monday, February 16th – President's Day

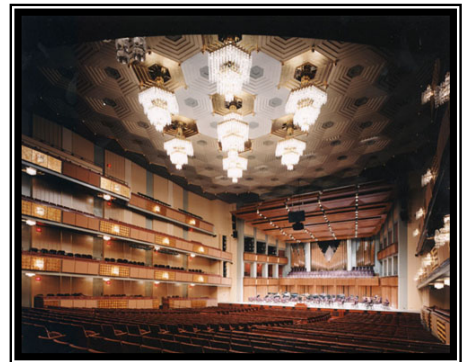
