reat Britain offers American performing groups the widest possible range of performance possibilities, including cathedrals, parish churches, music colleges, community centers, pavilions, concert halls, and theaters.

Many American traditions of government, justice, religion, the arts (especially literature and music) have their roots in Britain. A journey to Britain is a discovery of our own past and this experience is enhanced by the sharing of music with appreciative audiences. A shared concert with local orchestras, choirs, brass bands, and wind ensembles is recommended as part of the American Celebration of Music in Britain.

Great Britain has a long history that has created traditions that will stand forever, but one notices a great forward-looking optimism in this land of Shakespeare, Milton, Dickens, Churchill, the Windsors, the Beatles, and the late Princess Diana.

The American Celebration of Music is a special annual performance-tour program, co-sponsored by local governments, music associations, community organizations, and tourist boards around the globe. In many countries this has developed into a prestigious, recognized, year-long concert-series festival. Recognition of this festival facilitates greater access to performance venues, official publicity, generally very successful concert arrangements, and the ability to touch local cultures in a way that may not be done through other affiliations. This equates to more meaningful musical and emotional experiences for participating performance ensembles.

A festival-tour experience in Great Britain offers a unique combination of music, history and heritage. Performance opportunities range from the most prestigious cathedrals (Westminster Abbey / St. Margaret's, Canterbury Cathedral, York Minster) to concert halls, castle grounds, theaters and historic churches.

Select American groups are invited to share their talents in the very surroundings where Benjamin Britten, Gustav Holst, Ralph Vaughan Williams, Edward Elgar, Hubert Parry, William Byrd, and numerous other famous composers shared theirs.

STONEHENGE / CARDIFF / GLOUCESTER / STRATFORD / WARWICK OXFORD / WINDSOR / LONDON

DAY ONE: ARRIVE

Departure via scheduled air service to London

DAY TWO: STONEHENGE / CARDIFF

Arrive in London

Meet your MCI Tour Manager who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach for a transfer to Cardiff. Stop at Stonehenge, Europe's most famous prehistoric monument

Continue to Cardiff for late afternoon hotel check-in Evening Welcome Dinner and overnight at hotel

DAY THREE: CARDIFF

Take a guided tour of Cardiff Castle and visit the Museum of Welsh Life where you will travel back in time and experience how life in Wales would have been in the past.

DAY FOUR: CARDIFF / GLOUCESTER / STRATFORD WARWICK

Transfer to Stratford-upon-Avon stopping en route in Gloucester to visit the historic cathedral. Unpon arrival, enjoy a tour of the Shake-speare properties such as hi birthplace, Anne Hathaway's Cottage, and Holy Trinity Church.

Continue to Warwick

DAY FIVE: WARWICK / OXFORD / WINDSOR / LONDON

Transfer to London via Oxford to tour the world-famous town Continue to Windsor for a tour of Windsor Castle, which is today England's largest castle

DAY SIX: LONDON

Take a guided tour of London which includes the districts of Kensington and Knightsbridge. Pass Westminster Abbey and visit Whitehall and Trafalgar Square, Big Ben, and the Houses of Parliament to Buckingham Palace, and possibly see the changing of the Guard. Visit St. Paul's Cathedral and the Tower of London
