Strasbourg holds a unique position in both French and German history. One of the earliest documents in both languages is the Strasbourg Oaths sworn by two of the sons of Louis the Pious (himself the son of Charlemagne). Johann Gutenberg was an early citizen of Strasbourg experimenting with movable type. The French National Anthem is also associated with this city. Today Strasbourg is the headquarters of both the multinational Council of Europe and the European Parliament

Day 7	Strasbourg (B,D)
	This morning is devoted to exploring Strasbourg. "La Petite France" is the
	name given to the well-preserved and pedestrianized medieval quarter in the
	southwest section of the city. Its high gabled gingerbread houses on narrow
	streets and canals date from the 16th and 17th centuries when millers, tanners
	and fishermen thronged the area. Enjoy a canal ride through this medieval
	city
	Visit the Notre-Dame Cathedral (and Museum) which recalls the city's early
	ecclesiastical importance and the several centuries of struggles between

bishops and citizens
