### Day 1 Montréal

Arrive in Montréal

Sightseeing highlights today include Old Montréal, Mont Royal, St. Joseph's Oratory, Notre Dame Basilica and McGill University

### Day 3 Montréal

The Botanical Garden ranks as one of the world's largest and most spectacular and has a collection of 22,000 plant species, 10 greenhouses, and some 30 gardens

*Québec City or Québec (French: Ville de Québec, or simply Québec) is the capital of the Canadian province of Québec. It is the second largest city in the province, after Montréal. Québec's Old Town (Vieux-Québec), the only North American fortified city north of Mexico whose walls still exist, was declared a World Heritage Site by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in 1985 as the "Historic District of Old Québec". It is also one of the oldest cities in North America.*

Afternoon guided tour of Québec City's La Citadelle. This national historic site is a walled fortress of the city. Also visit the Royal 22 Regiment Museum. Then wander Dufferin Terrace and view le Chateau Frontenac

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### **Day 5 Québec City**

Breakfast at the hotel

Journey along the St. Lawrence River to view the spectacular and history filled Beauport Coast. Continuing along the Avenue Royale, one of the oldest streets in North America, to the village of Sainte-Anne which houses one of the country's most beautiful cathedrals

Stops are made to view the lovely Montmorency Falls and a typical Québec bake oven

Dinner will be at Ile d'Orleans at a typical French Sugar Shack
