Sunday, January 18th, 2009

Arrival in Washington, D.C.

Sightseeing may include a panoramic tour of the Capitol Hill area, the Supreme Court Building, and the Library of Congress

Check into hotel

Dinner at a local restaurant

Evening walking tour of the World War II, Lincoln, Korean, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, Vietnam, and Jefferson Memorials



Monday, January 19th

Half-day morning tour of historic Mount Vernon and Old Towne Alexandria

Half-day afternoon tour of Embassy Row, Smithsonian Institute's American History, Natural History, or the Air & Space Museum

Evening tour of the Jefferson and Iwo Jima Memorials

Transfer to the parade staging area

Depart the staging area for the assembly area, where box lunch is provided

Participate in the 2009 Presidential Inaugural Parade on historic Pennsylvania Avenue

Following the parade, depending on schedule, sightseeing continues and may include one of the Smithsonian Institute Museums

Dinner at a local restaurant, the Union Station, or at the Old Post Office Pavilion

Breakfast at the hotel

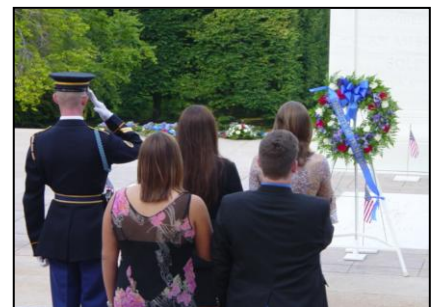
Morning check-out and board motorcoaches
