### DIRECTOR PREVIEW TOUR

March 15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010

#### Monday, March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010

Depart from USA via scheduled air service, including in-flight entertainment. The destination is Dublin, Ireland.

#### Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Dublin

Arrive in Dublin. Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach for a panoramic tour of Dublin's highlights including visiting either St. Patrick's Cathedral or Christ Church Cathedral. Also visit the Guinness Storehouse (possible performance venue). Mid-afternoon hotel check-in. Reception in the Mansion House/Lord Mayors Residence with a presentation of invitations to potential band directors. Evening Welcome Dinner in the city and overnight at Burlington Hotel (or similar).

#### Wednesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Dublin

Breakfast at the hotel

10:15am – Depart for St. Patrick's Day Parade

12:00pm – Parade begins, seating can be arranged in the stands all around the city

2:30pm – Parade ends

*St. Patrick's Festival Parade snakes its way through the city center. International and Irish marching bands join performers, dancers and street theatre companies to present a wonderfully entertaining parade. The parade is a piece of moving theatre, complete with its own Creative Director. Colorful costumes, flamboyant performances and outstanding musical talent.*

Late lunch at your hotel. Possible attendance at Awards Ceremony at the National Concert Hall. Evening dinner, music and entertainment in the Abbey Tavern (or similar). Return to hotel for overnight.

#### Thursday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Dublin

Breakfast at the hotel. Today enjoy a visit to Glendalough and the Wicklow Mountains. The steep wooded slopes of Glendalough the "valley of the two lakes" harbor one of Ireland's most atmospheric monastic sites — established in the 6th century. Here we visit the Round Tower, Cathedral, St. Kevin's Cross and Kitchen, and Gatehouse. Return to Dublin via Bray and Dalkey. Visit the National Museum Collins Barracks Dublin (possible performance venue). Dinner on own. Overnight in Dublin.

#### Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Depart for home

Breakfast and hotel check-out. Transfer to Dublin's International Airport for return flight to USA. Arrive home in the evening of the same day.
