

Luggage/Transportation Information

Luggage Allowance for International Groups:

Each member is allowed:

1 piece not to exceed 62 inches, (length, width & height) or weighing more than 50-70 pounds, as a check-in for the luggage compartment.

1 piece of carry-on, not to exceed 45 inches (length, width & height) which will fit either in an overhead compartment or under a seat.

Instruments:

If you are an instrumental group, your instrument will count as one additional piece of luggage. The same dimensions and weight apply when packing instruments. Smaller instrument cases (flute) can be packed directly into your carry-on luggage. Trumpets, guitars, clarinets etc., can be taken onto the airplane as the carry-on. You would then have to limit any additional carry-on luggage to backpack or purse size.

When packing instruments, keep in mind that large cartons which can fit on the airlines may not be accommodated in motorcoaches. Do not try to pack many instruments in one large carton. Keep the weight of large instruments as close to 50-70 pounds as possible. Keep equipment at a minimum. Remember the instruments and equipment you bring is what you will have to carry, transfer to each performance, store during sightseeing, move with each city transfer, and re-pack for the return trip. Bus drivers are not responsible to load and unload luggage and/or equipment.
